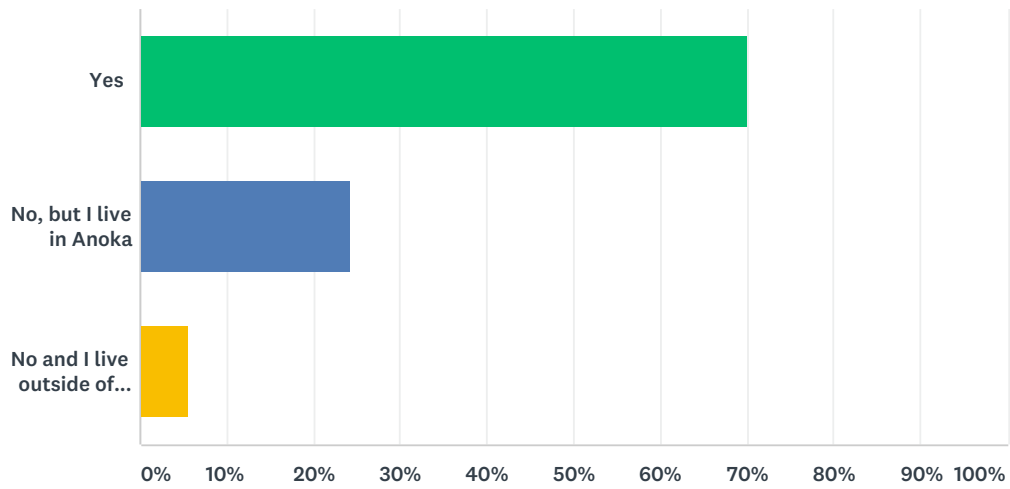

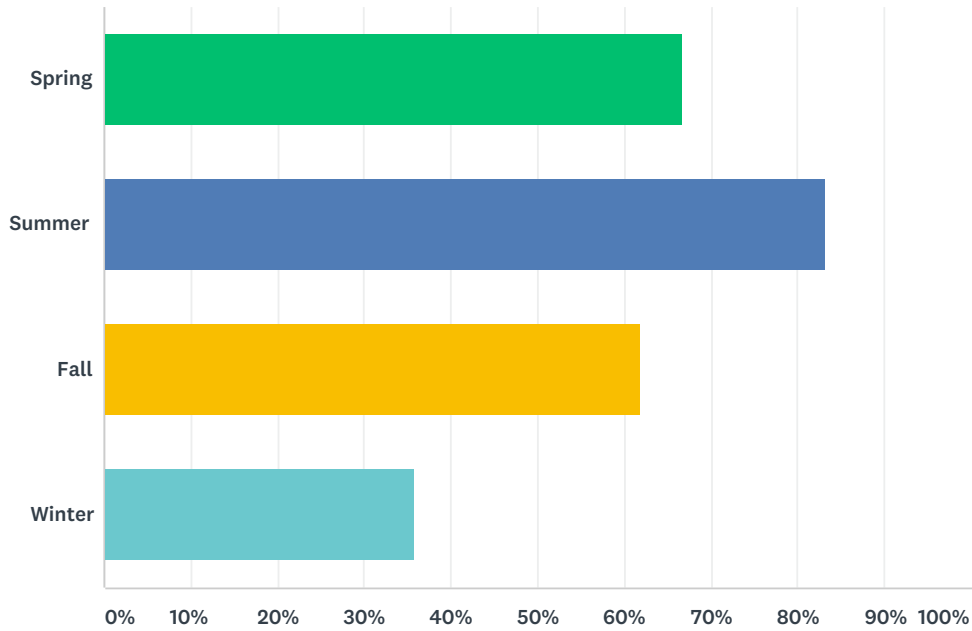

### Q5 Which season(s) do you most often visit the park? Select all that apply.

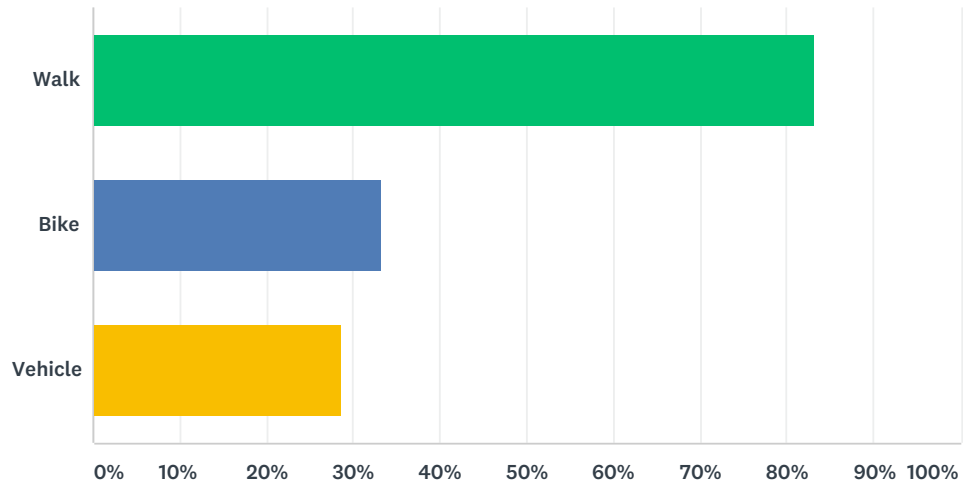

### Q6 How do you access the park?

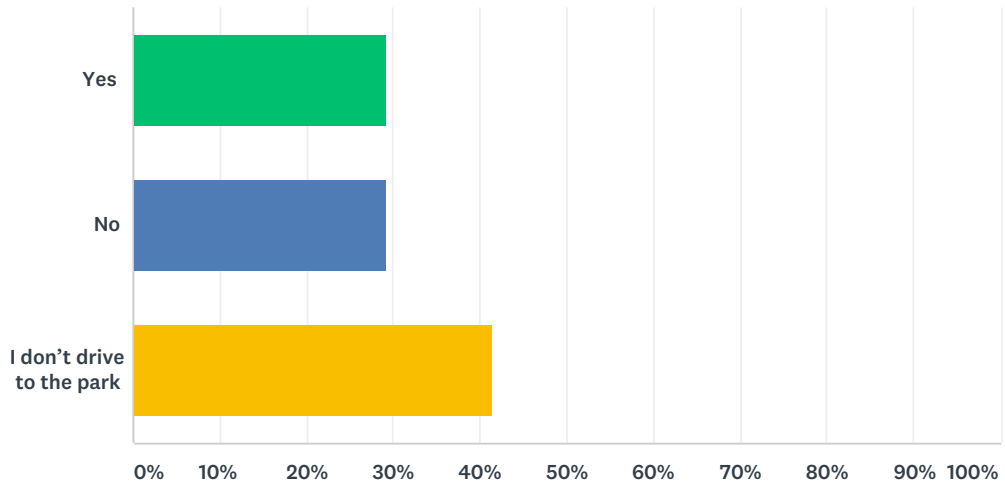

### Q7 Does the park need more vehicle parking?

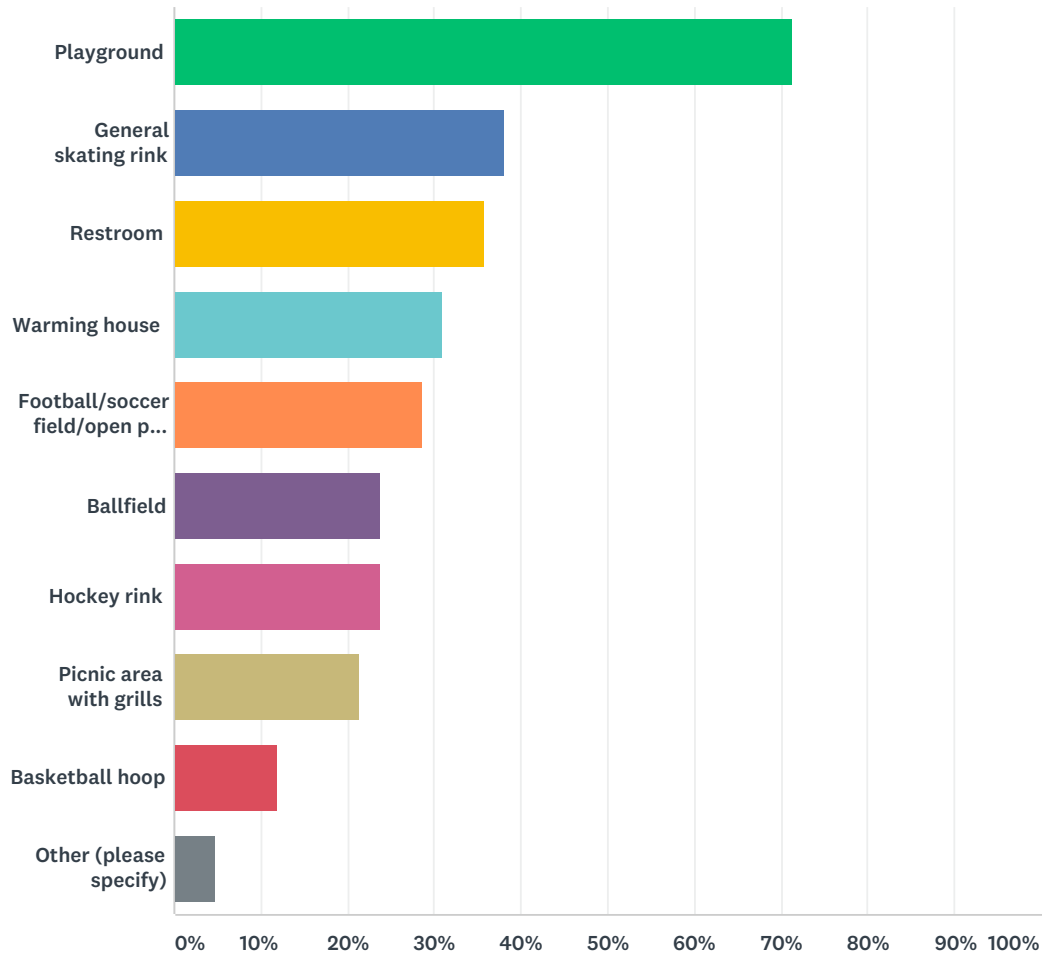

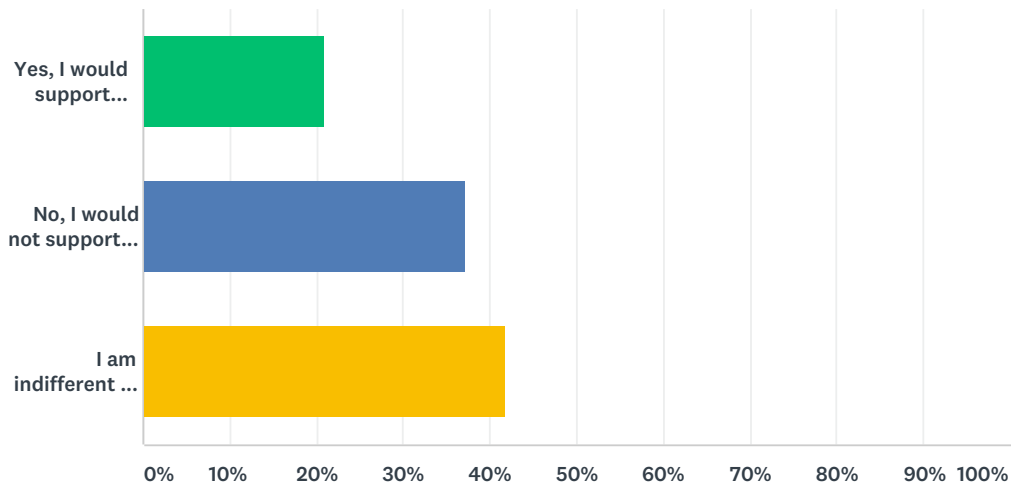

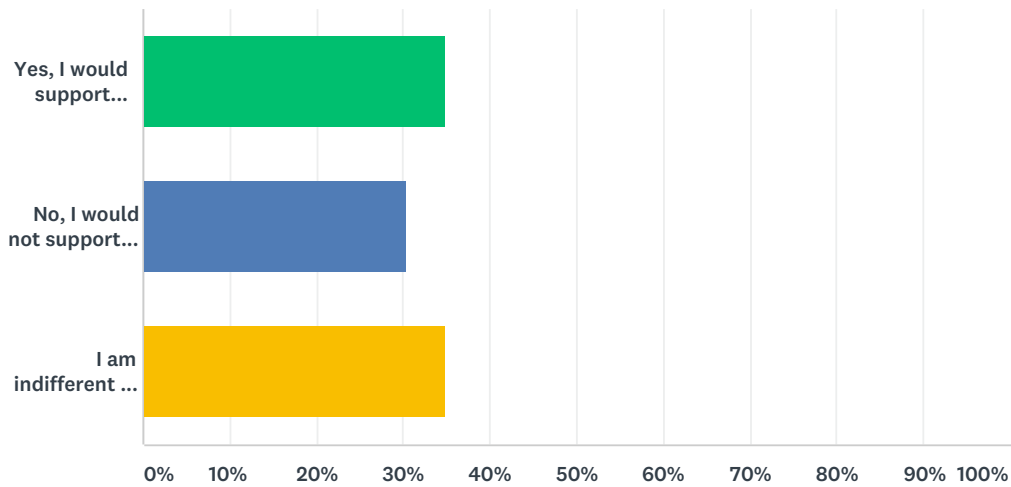

### Q10 Would you support removing the existing ballfield and replacing it with other amenities?

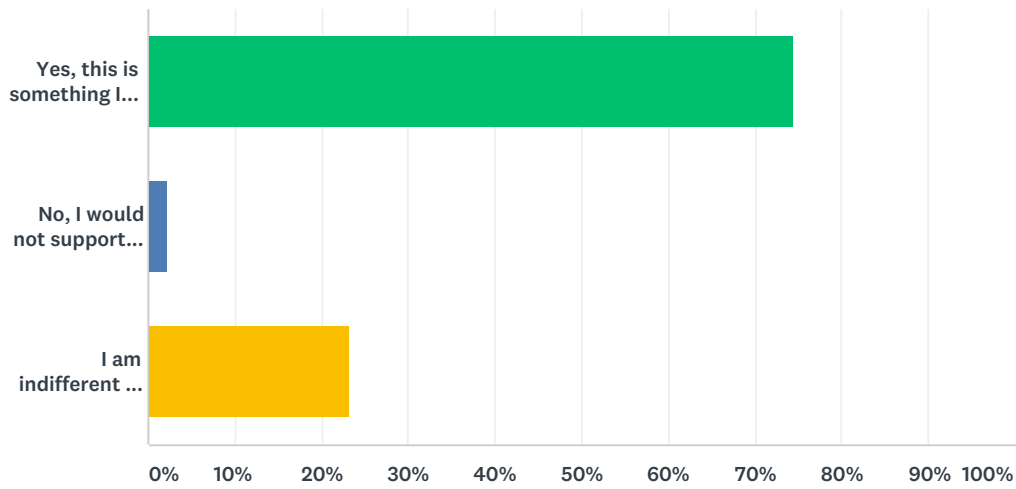

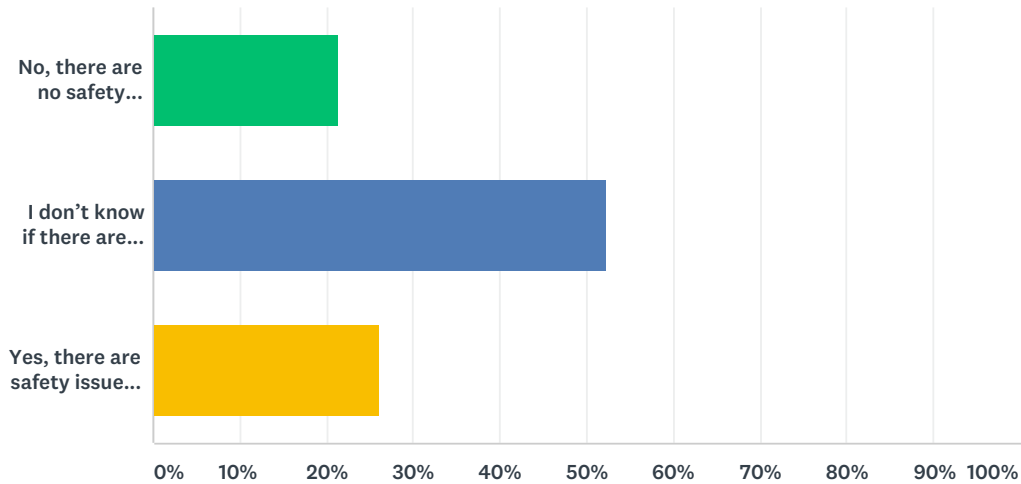

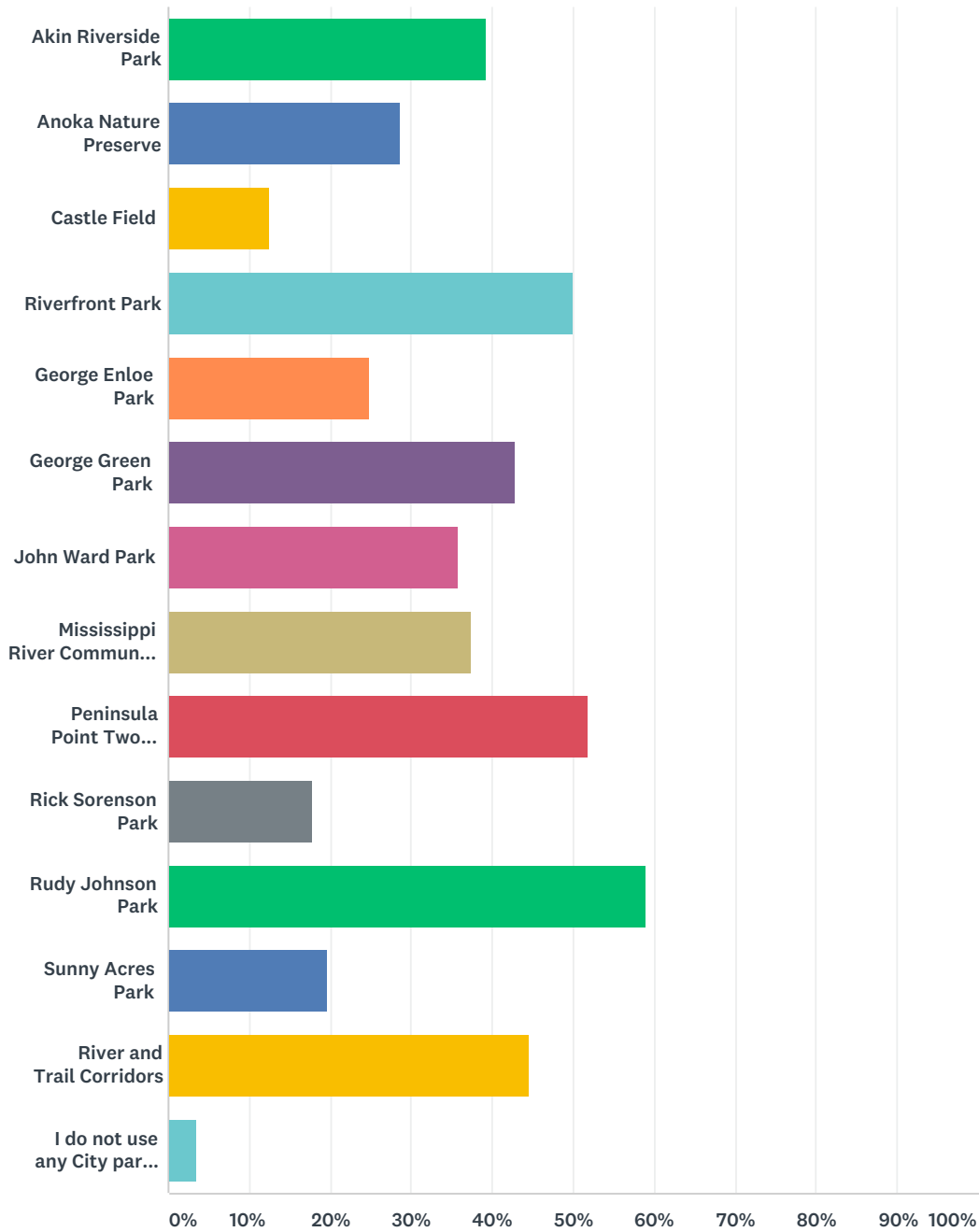

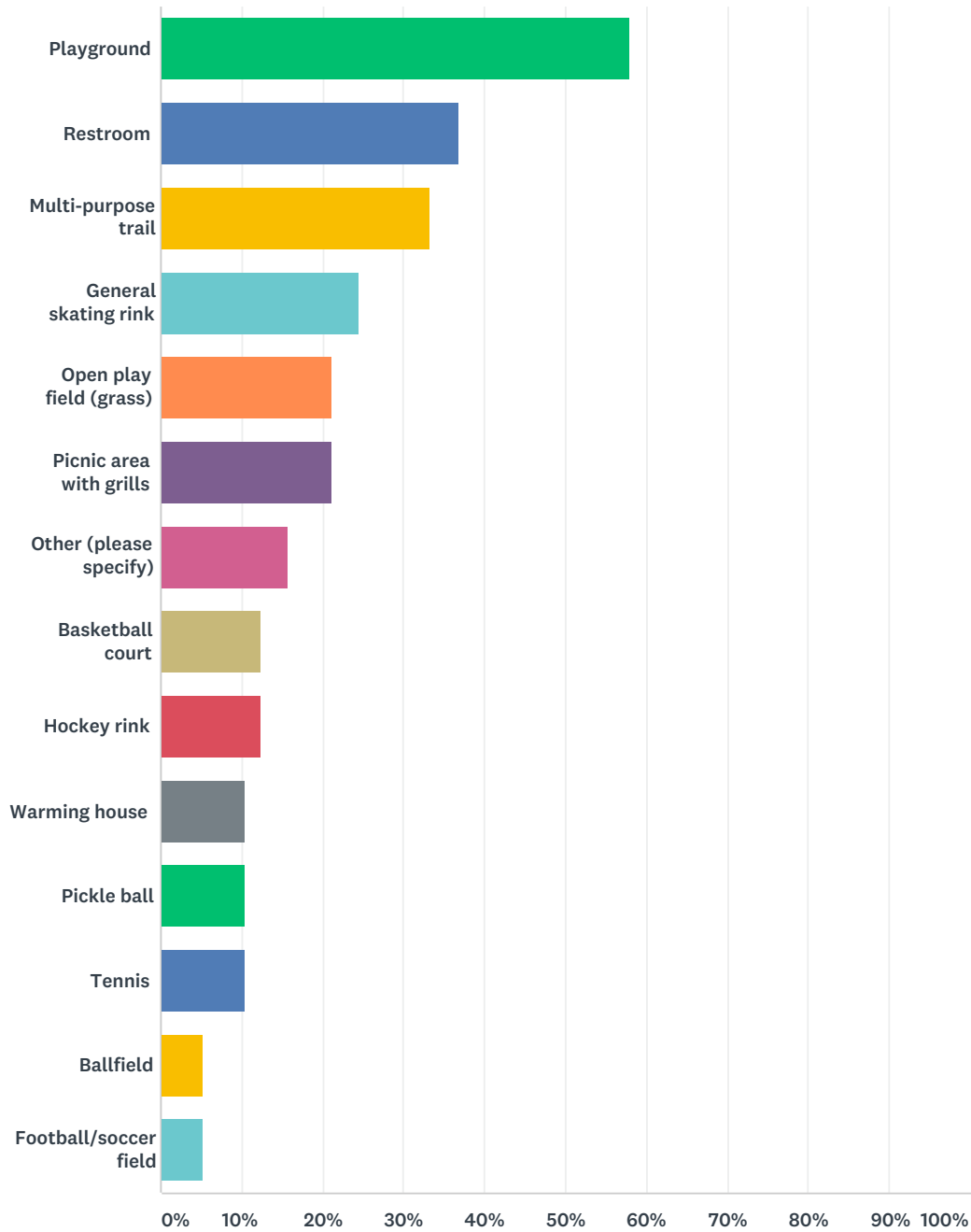

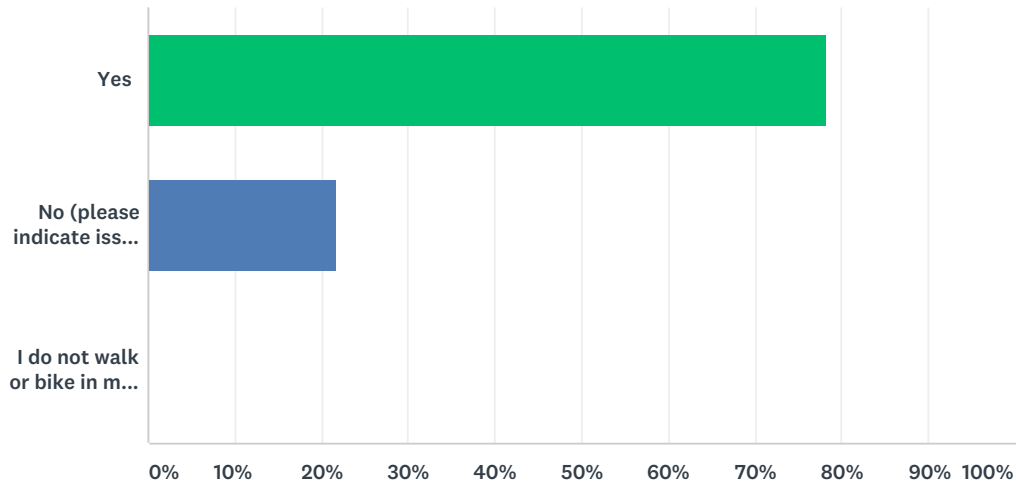

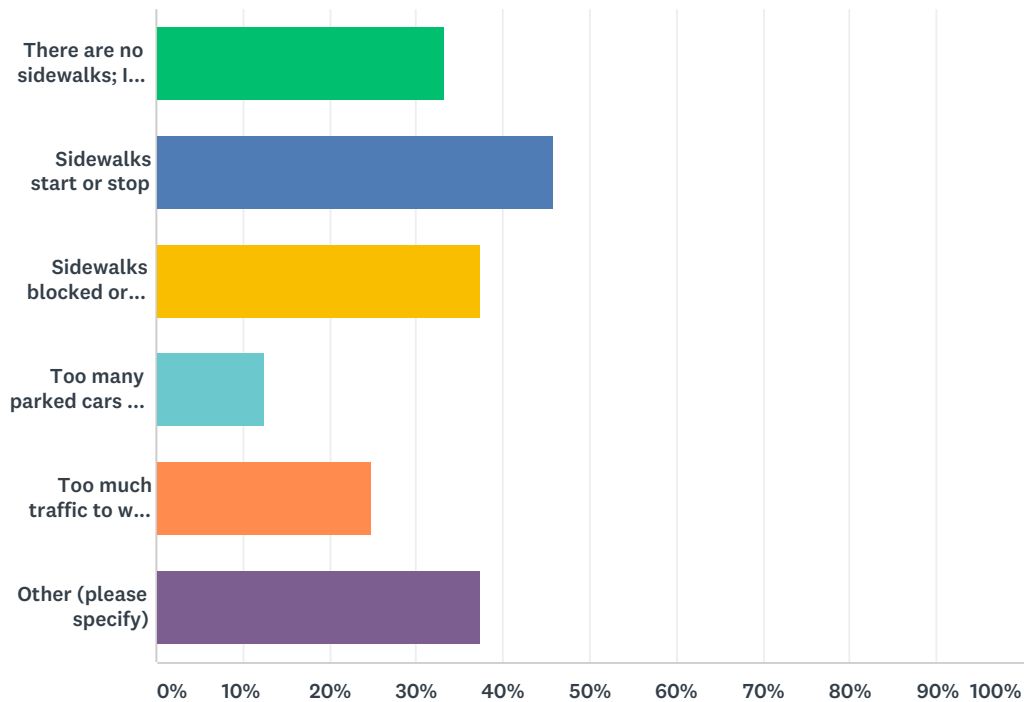

### Q19 Is it easy to cross streets in your neighborhood?

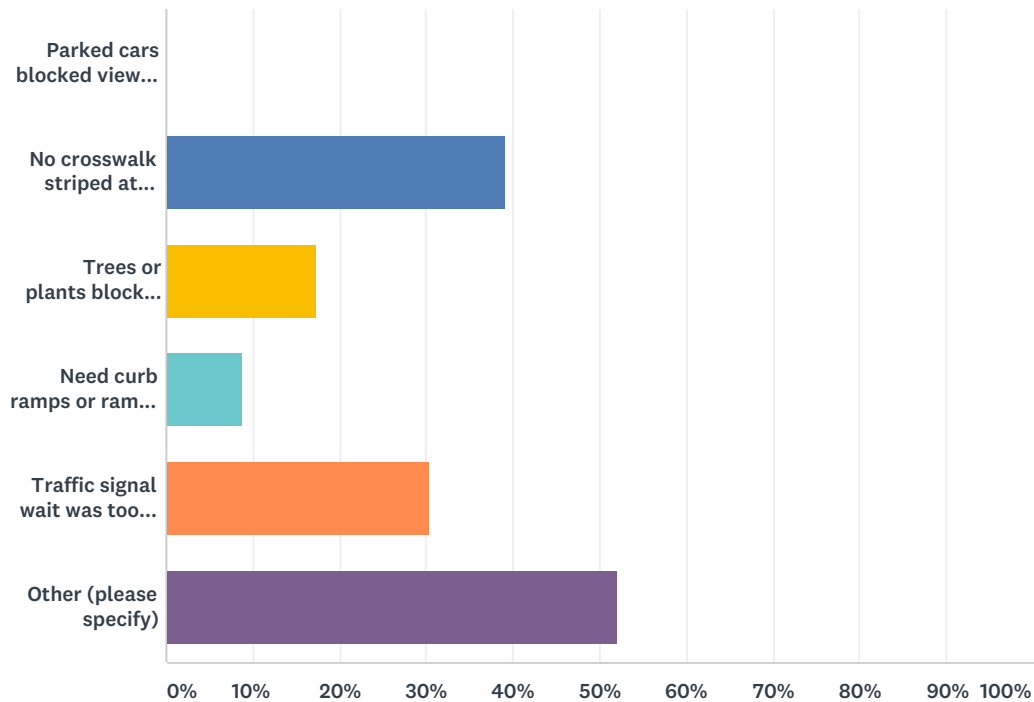

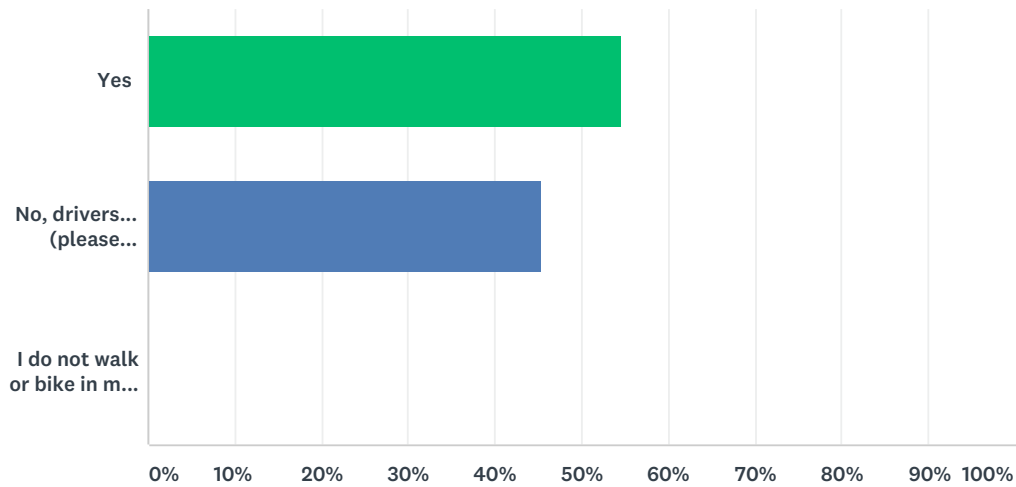

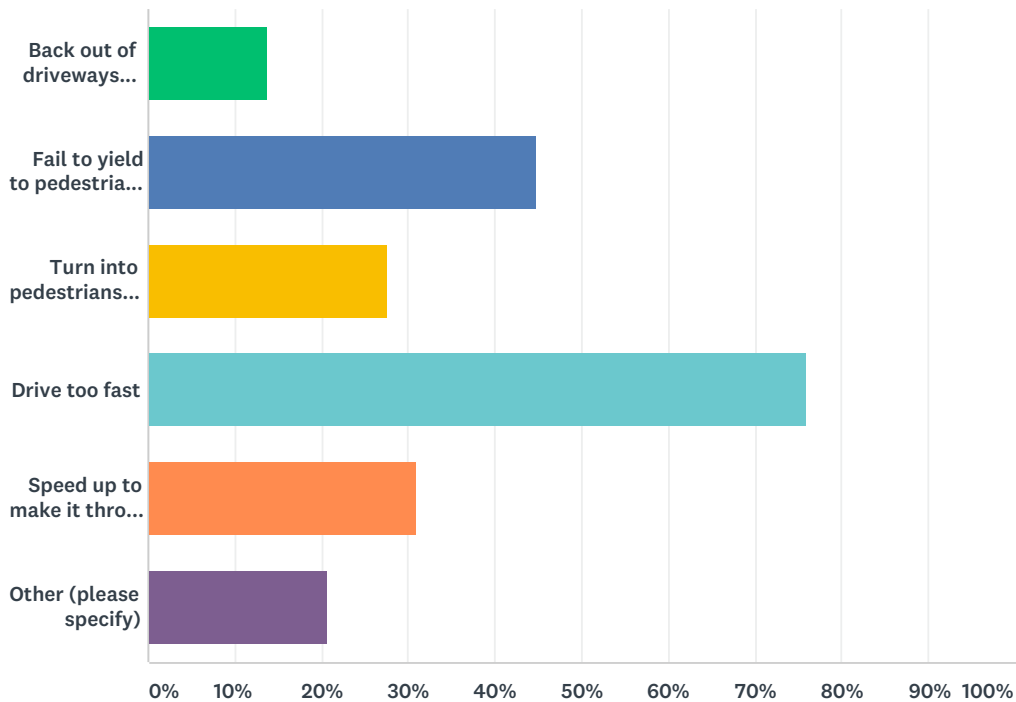

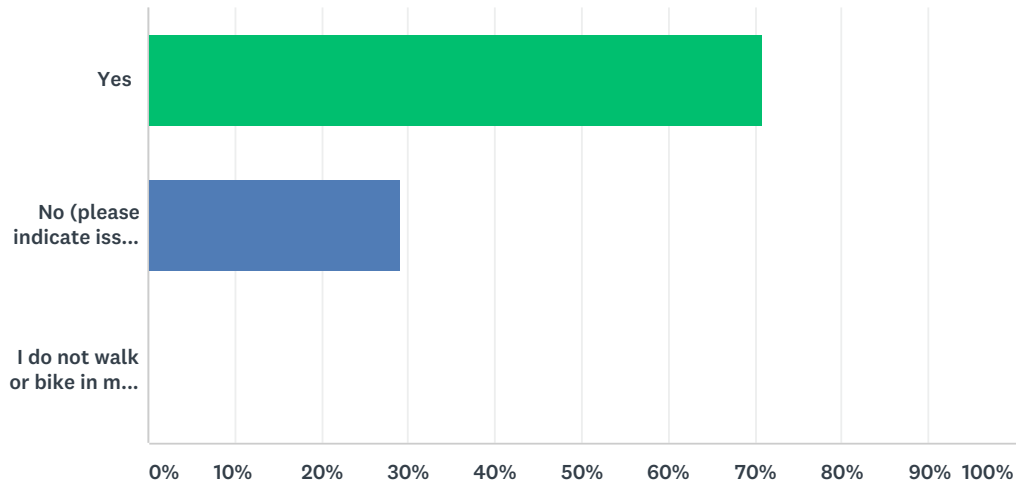

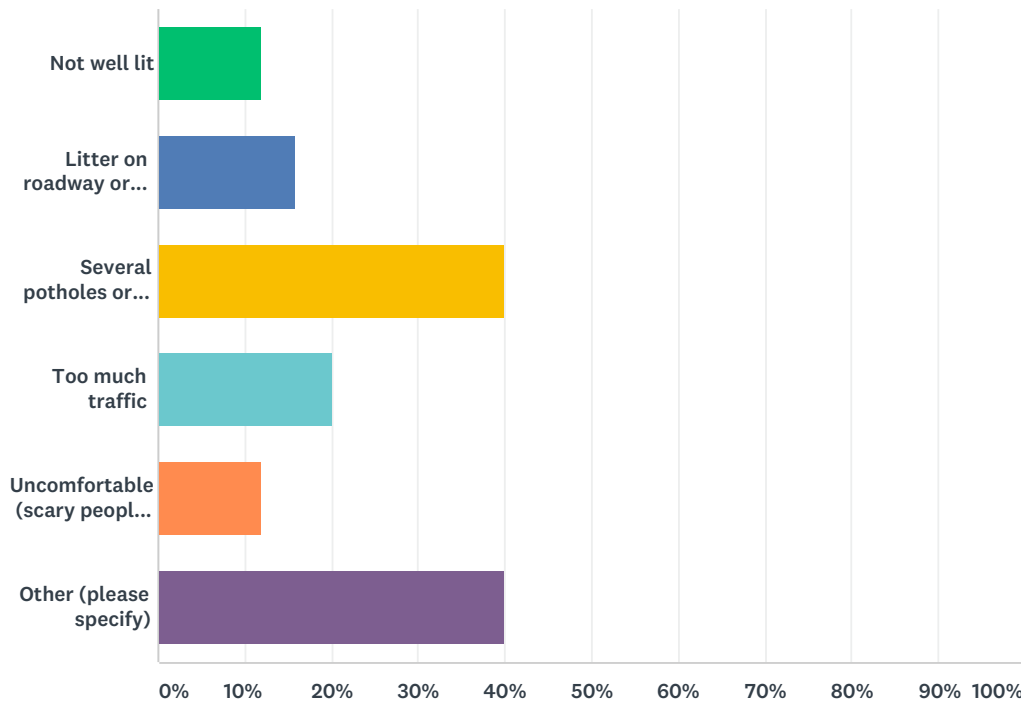
